### Browser – definition

Discuss choices: Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox (library), and Netscape

### WWW – definition

URL – definition (name, and number with format 192.168.1.1)

Domain names – (with the .com, .org, .net etc.)

### ISP Connection

- Selecting
- Services (Internet access, email, storage space, web page/hosting, support)
- Types of: (DSL=digital subscriber line; ISDN integrated services digital networks, a standard dial-up; fiber optic connection)
- Cost – including free

### Accessing the Browser

- Double click on program icon
- Right click on program icon and select “open home page”
- Click START and select program name

### Browser Window Features

- Title Bar with Min/Max/Close
- Menu bar
- Tool bar
- Address bar
- Status bar
- Hyperlinks (click; click with Shift Key)
- Scrolling Arrows

### Tool Bar

Note Yahoo, Google, MSN, etc. all have a tool bar with links to their special services.

- Forward
- Stop (escape)
- Refresh (F5)
- Home\*\*
- Favorites
- History
- Full Screen (and f11 toggle)
- Mail
- Print/Print Preview\*\*
- Edit
- Find (CTL+F)
- Copy/cut/paste (CTL+C/X/V)

- File/New
- File/Print\*\*
- File/Save and File/Save As\*\*
- Tools/PopUp Blocker
- Tools/Internet Options
